A) Centre Operations and Members Services

1. Updates on General Safe Management Measures at SGS Centres

- In view of the further easing of community safe management measures (SMMs) from 29 August 2022, mask wearing is not needed for short duration visits to SGS centres lasting less than half-an-hour, such as for making donations.

Why was that? Because, explained Shakyamuni, her lamp was offered with the most pure-hearted sincerity and a lofty vow to illuminate the darkness of all living beings.

His articles have appeared in *Diplomatic History*, the *Journal of American-East Asian Relations*, and *International Journal*. Ngoei's first book, *Arc of Containment: Britain, the United States, and Anticommunism in Southeast Asia* (Cornell University Press) examined how British decolonisation intertwined with Southeast Asian anticommunist nationalism to usher the region from formal European-dominated colonialism to U.S. hegemony.
